

ANNOUNCEMENT EXTRAORDINARY

IMPERIAL WIZARD WILL VISIT COLORADO SEPTEMBER 5TH AND 6TH

FORT COLLINS-SEPTEMBER 5TH - PUEBLO-SEPTEMBER 6TH

We are glad to announce to our Klans in the Realm of Colorado that the Imperial Wizard and other Imperial Officers will be with us for two full days, September 5th and 6th.

At the request of many of our Klans in the State, the time has been divided so that the largest possible attendances might be secured for these great meetings. The meeting in Fort Collins for September 5th is designed to reach all of the Klans in northern, northeastern and northwestern Colorado, and the meeting in Pueblo for the 6th is designed to reach the Klans in southern, southeastern and southwestern Colorado. The program in each place will be substantially as follows:

1. A meeting at 10 o'clock for Hydras, Great Titans, Furies, Exalted Cyclops, Terrors and other Klan leaders in conference with the Imperial Wizard and others.
2. At two o'clock there will be a great mass meeting for Klanspeople only in closed session for Klansmen, Klanswomen, Juniors, Tri-K's, and Crusaders. At this meeting Dr. Evans will bring his powerful message relative to the campaign which is being set up in every Realm in the nation in the tremendous fight which the Klan will make to meet the Smith situation during the next twelve months. No Klansmen can afford to miss this inspiring meeting.
3. At 7:30 a giant parade will be staged with all Klan organizations participating. Music, fireworks, and other spectacular effects will be followed by a public speaking at which the Imperial Wizard will be the principal speaker.

These two meetings will be the greatest Klan demonstrations ever held in the State of Colorado. We are making these preliminary announcements, asking that all of our local Klans get together immediately, lining up the largest possible delegations for these meetings. Whip a musical organization into shape if you can for the parade. Every Klan should enter some kind of an elaborately decorated automobile or float.

Within a few days we will send you a Bulletin giving the names of the halls where the meetings will be held in each city. Wherever it is possible, encourage your Klansmen to attend both of the meetings, that is, at Fort Collins and Pueblo. The Pueblo meeting, which will be held in connection with the State Fair, should see thousands of Klansmen in line for the effect that it will have upon the aliens who attend the State Fair.

In preparation for your participation in the parades the Exalted Cyclops will require that the robes of his Klansmen be laundered. Every Exalted Cyclops should make a determined effort to have some kind of float or special attractions provided for his men in the parade. It will be a pleasing feature, too, if every Klan will provide its membership with colored hand flares for the parade. This adds largely to the spectacular effect.

IMPORTANT RULING FOR KLIGRAPPS

Hereafter when robes are withdrawn by members for the purpose of washing them, for funerals, or for other minor uses, the Kligrapp will upon issuing his robe take up the Klansman's card and return it to him when the robe is returned to the Klavern. In this way robes will not be lost and you will have protection against disagreeable happenings that might arise when Klansmen are permitted to take their robes and are not held responsible for them. Therefore, in having the robes laundered for the parade, see that the cards are taken up while the launder work is being looked after.
